

CITY CENTRE PLAN



1. Town Hall - Market Square

It was designed in 1828 by Johann Heinrich Hüberlin, a close associate of the Berlin architect Karl Friedrich Schinkel. It was modernised in 1862 and 1948. In the building are housed the Museum of the Town of Ostrów Wielkopolski, a Wedding Hall and a kiosk with publications and souvenirs.



2. Table of the mayor Stefan Rowiński - Market Place

Stefan Rowiński (1875-1943) was the first mayor of Ostrów after independence. During the partitions he was an active organiser of Polish national life, led in Ostrów a bookstore, a printing and publishing house "Gazeta Ostrowska". He was a participant of Republic of Ostrów events. The monument was designed and created by an Ostrów artist Agnieszka Lisiak "Skórka".



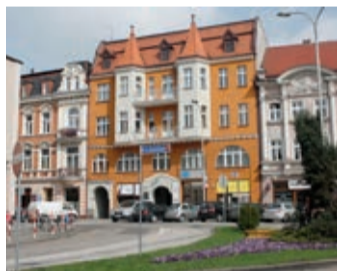
3. St. Stanislaus Bishop and Martyr Church (now co-cathedral) - Gimnazjalna Street

Neo-Romanesque church, was built between 1904-1906, designed by Sylwester Pajzderski and Roger Sławski. The interior is decorated with polychrome from 1929 by Henry Nostitz-Jackowski and sculptures of famous artists from Greater Poland Władysław Marcinkowski and Marcin Rożek.



4. Statue of Cardinal Mieczysław Halka-Ledóchowski - Polish Primate - Kardynała M. Ledóchowskiego Street (square at the co-cathedral)

The monument was erected in 1925 as a vote of residents of Greater Poland and Ostrów for the regained freedom after years of captivity. The cardinal Mieczysław Halka-Ledóchowski was held in the years 1874-1876 in the Ostrów prison. The monument was destroyed by the Germans in 1939. In 1984, a sculpture of the cardinal by Łucja Skomorowska-Wilimowska was unveiled.



5. 6. Buildings from the neo-baroque period

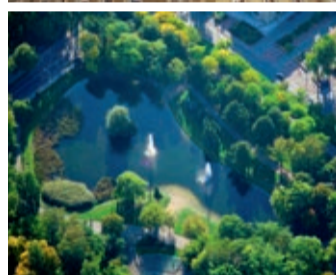
One of the most representative houses of



the town is the building of the former Cash Loan at the Rowiński Square. It was built in the second half of the 19th century and rebuilt in 1907 and it gained a new neo-baroque decoration of the facade. The same styling presents the corner house at the intersection of Wrocławska and Wiosny Ludów Streets.

7. Town Park - between Piłsudskiego Street and Powstańców Wielkopolskich avenue

It is located in the town centre, with an amphitheatre. There are numerous hiking and biking alleys, a pond with fountains. It is a place of open-air concerts and Festivities, among other things Municipal Festivity majOSTaszk.



8. The Church of Our Lady Queen of Poland - Królowej Jadwigi Street

It is a former evangelical church, now Roman Catholic church, built between 1777 and 1778 in a half-timbered construction. The interior of the church is in the Baroque Style, with two storeys of wooden tribunes. In 1855, it was erected a brick, neo-Romanesque tower.



9. Synagogue - Raszowska Street

It was built between 1857 and 1860 in the area of the former Jewish district. The builder was a bricklayer master Moritz Landé. It was decorated with elements of Moorish art. In the years 2010-2011, it was restored with EU funds. Currently it operates as a Forum Synagoga and hosts numerous cultural events.



10. Lapidarium - 23 Stycznia Square

It was established in 2008 with recovered fragments of tombstones of an outline of the first Jewish cemetery. Matzevots with inscriptions have been subjected to maintenance. The whole is surrounded by a sandstone wall. On the north side is a plate with the inscription in Polish and Hebrew with the words "And shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it."



MONUMENTS AND TOURIST ATTRACTIONS



11. Cultural Centre of Ostrów - Wolności Street

It is a dynamic local cultural institution. It organizes a number of significant, recurring events and intimate meetings with authors, cabaret evenings and art exhibitions in the PIK Gallery. The OCK is partially housed in the former Municipal Theatre built in 1910. In 2008-2010, the facility was modernized. Currently, there is among other things a large and small auditorium, Cultural Information Centre, a cafe.



12. St. Anthony of Padua church - Raszowska Street

It is a modernistic church, built between 1938 and 1947, designed by Franciszek Morawski. Stained glass windows are from 1947 from a studio of Henry Nostitz-Jackowski. The polychrome was made in 1977-78 by Julian Wiącek. The tower and the parish buildings are connected with the church cloisters.



13. and 14. Stained-glass windows

A complex of stained glass windows located in the former Grammar School for Boys (now 1st Secondary School) was built in the 2nd half of the 80s in the 19th century from the studio of Edward Frank, previously owned by the famous Adolf Seiler - creator of stained glass windows "Salvator Mundi." The colourful stained glass windows depict allegories of Labour (Labor), Knowledge (Scientia) and Art (Ars Libera). A complex of six stained-glass windows in the building of the former sewage pumping station at the intersection of Raszowska, Wańkowicza streets and Słowackiego avenue dates from the early 20th century and represents the views of the old Ostrów among other things water tower, Market Square with the town hall, buildings of gasworks and waterworks.



15. 16. 17. Art Nouveau townhouses

An interesting example of Art Nouveau in Ostrów is a villa at Raszowska street 47 (built 1905). The first owner of the building was an associated with Free-

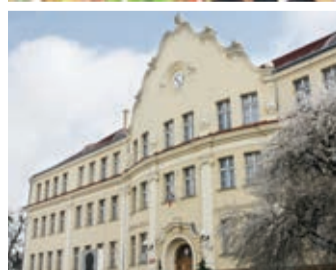


masonry Schulz and hence on one wall bears Masonic symbolism. In 1909, it was built a corner house at the intersection of Głogowska and Zamenhofs Streets. This four-storey building has a preserved until today an Art Nouveau decoration of the facade. Art Nouveau style has also received an erected in 1900 villa of a builder Paul Kupke (Sienkiewicza Street 2a). The houses of Ewald Neumann at Kolejowa Street 4-6, were erected in the early 20th century in Berlin Art Nouveau, tough.



18. Old Cemetery - Bank Square

It is one of the oldest Polish cemeteries. It is the final resting place of many people permanently written in the history of the town, both through its participation in the fighting forces, and in social, business, scientific and artistic work in the 19th and 20th centuries. The value of the cemetery makes also the graves, which represent a large variety of forms. The oldest preserved tombstone is from 1842.



19. 20. Architecture of 20 years interwar period

The building of the "Ewaryst Estkowski" Public School (now School No. 2), located at Wrocławska street, was built between 1925 and 1926. It was designed by Franciszek Sterczyński. From this period is also the building of Polish Bank (now Santander Bank Polska S.A.) at the Bank Square. It was built 1928-1930, designed by Stanisław Filasiewicz. In the years 1947-1951 lived here a prominent composer Krzysztof Komeda-Trzcirski.



21. Sports and Recreation Centre Piaski-Szczygliczka - Plaźowa Street

It is located close to the water reservoir in the northern part of the town, with sandy beaches and numerous attractions among other things Rope Adventure Park, promenade for pedestrians and bicycle drivers around the lagoon, children's playgrounds and multi-purpose sports field with an artificial turf.



MONUMENTS AND TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

A vibrant atmosphere of the city centre, with the Market Square, restaurants, narrow streets makes Ostrów Wielkopolski a unique place. It is in the city centre, especially in the summertime, with many open-air cafés, where the city life is the most vibrant.

The Today's Ostrów is not only a cosy and picturesque downtown. The city, with around 72 thousands of inhabitants, is an important economic, cultural and sports centre of the region of southern Greater Poland. It is located approx. 100 km from Poznań, Wrocław and Łódź. Thanks to the various forms of business support, Ostrów Wielkopolski has become more and more attractive for investments. The city is open to those who are interested in economy sphere, as well as to those who want to relax or seek cultural or sports emotions. The city has a wide cultural offer. The International Chopin Festival in the Colours of Autumn, the International Biennial of Small Graphic Forms and Ex – Libris, the Krzysztof Komeda Film Festival, the festivals "Everything is Poetry" and "Mazel Tov", the Jazz Festival, the Jimiway Blues Festi-

val, Reggae on Piaski, the National Festival of Independent Theaters are events that enjoy great interest of audience and first – class artists.

A very popular among residents are big events, such as: the City Festival "majOSTaszki" or annual Easter and Christmas Fairs. Ostrówians love sport, active lifestyle and outdoor recreation. A lot of fans have: the men's team BM SLAM Stal Ostrowia, the female team of the Towarzystwo Sportowe Ostrowia, the team of KPR Ostrowia or speedway team Ostrowia. The speedway showcase of the city is the Coat of Arms Chain of Ostrów Wielkopolski Tournament, the oldest speedway tournament in Poland and the second oldest tournament in Europe. A very popular discipline is also football. In the city there is football team Ostrowia 1909 – one of the oldest football teams in Poland and KP Centra 1946. The Ostrów athletics also achieve great successes. Athletes from the Stal LA Sports Club score points in the sports competitions of children and youth. Close to Ostrów, there is the Airport in Michalków with a pro-



fessional parachute zone "Pyrlandia Boogie". Invariably, for many years, very popular among the residents of Ostrów, but also the residents of the entire South Wielkopolska, is the Recreation and Sports Centre Piaski – Szczygliczka. The enthusiasts of history will find in Ostrów traces of many cultures. For many years, Polish, Jewish and German communities, have lived here in concord, creating a rich history. The evidence of their presence in the city are, among others, sacred buildings (Evangelical and Catholic churches and the Synagogue). Today the Synagogue, thoroughly renovated thanks to EU funds – the "Synagogue Forum", has become a very important cultural centre in the city. Let's meet in Ostrów Wielkopolski! We encourage you to stay here longer, according to the words of Ostrów's poet "there are some places in the world that offer you love, so that you want to stay here longer."
